Rules and conditions

1. Return the entry form to Lazonby Village Hall postbox in the main porch a.s.a.p. and no later than **Friday 16th September**, or post to Lazonby Village Hall, Lazonby, Penrith. CA10 1AQ
2. Bring your **homemade** dessert to the Village Hall between **12.30 and 1.15 p.m.** on Sunday 18th September. N.B. We are not able to keep puddings hot. Chilled puds should be well chilled right up to bringing them to the hall. Please avoid uncooked eggs in recipes.
3. At the hall, you will be given an entry card with your entry number, name and description of pud and list of ingredients to display next to your entry. Your name is not displayed.
4. The public vote by selecting 4 puddings for £1 and are given a small taste of each. They then vote for their favourite, giving 3 points for 1st, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3rd. People can purchase more than one ticket, i.e. taste 8 puds for £2 etc.
5. The pudding with the most points in each class is the winner. Quality Prizes for winners and runners up in each class.
6. Please ensure high standards of food hygiene and safety in preparation of all entries.
7. Left-overs and serving dishes must be collected straight after the event.
8. Entries for under 16s should be the **work of the entrant** with adequate adult supervision in preparation suited to the age of the child.
